

KEEP MONTGOMERY COUNTY BEAUTIFUL JULY BOARD MEETING

Held at 19603 Timber Ridge, Indigo Lakes Estates, Magnolia, Texas on July 25

Meeting Called to Order at 16:10

PRESENT: Charlotte Harris, Phyllis Stegan, Glenn Buckley

APPROVED JUNE MINUTES: Yes 3; Opposed 0

FINANCIALS: Deferred pending Phyllis having a chance to better understand past accounting especially how categories were defined.

PROJECTS:

- + City Hall – currently not maintained by city – needs either commitment from city or volunteer organization
- + City Library – Charlotte has support of commissioner’s office for a beautification project to include plantings, benches, planter boxes. A good candidate for a KMCB grant once the volunteers have been recruited.
- + Scout November 15 Service Day – Local troops/packs may be candidates to execute parts of library project. Need to make a list of other service opportunities around city to distribute to troops and packs. Charlotte will contact local Scoutmaster and Glenn will contact district representative. Need to work on publicity.

GRANTS

Union Pacific - Agreed to purchase 10 recycling bins for the city, conditional on their approval of type and location.

HEB – Phyllis will check on whether we received check and how it was accounted for.

FOCUS AREA – Currently spread too thin to cover entire county. Need to focus to improve volunteers and funding. Proposed that focus on greater Magnolia area (essentially Pct 2). Several outstanding questions arise that need resolution:

1. Can Keep Magnolia Beautiful be a project within Keep Montgomery County Beautiful or should we form an entirely new organization with KMCB the umbrella org.
2. How do we related to other Keep Texas Beautiful Afficiates such as Keep Willis Beautiful and Montgomery County Beautification Assoc.
